

## Volunteer Role Profile: Learning Assistant



<b>Purpose of Role</b>	To assist with activities organised for children and young people in the museum or across the site.
<b>Anticipated Time Contribution</b>	Irregular commitment can be discussed and agreed with the Community and Learning Officer. One off support for events is welcome.
<b>Main Activities or Duties</b>	<p>Leading or supporting activities for children in organised groups or for individual family visits, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Craft activities in holidays</li> <li>• Helping with school groups</li> <li>• Offering ideas for activities</li> <li>• Helping with under-fives activities</li> </ul>
<b>Requirements and Competencies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Friendly and approachable</li> <li>• Experience of supporting children to enjoy activities useful but not essential</li> <li>• Reliable</li> </ul>
<b>Training</b>	From the museum staff as appropriate but all activities will be carefully planned with instructions as required.
<b>Benefits</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Volunteers who are available for 6 hours in the day are provided with a free lunch from a limited menu in the on-site café</li> <li>• Free refreshments at break times</li> <li>• Uniform (Wheal Martyn polo shirt provided)</li> <li>• 10% discount on selected items in shop</li> </ul>
<b>Notes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Volunteering in this role may support someone who is looking to gain skills which may lead to a range of roles working with children and young people.</li> <li>• DBS clearance may be required.</li> </ul>
